1. **Faculty support:** Faculty members of both K. C. Das Commerce College and Tinsukia Commerce College may deliver lecture(s) as resource persons for portions or special topics of a few identified courses with mutual consultation at a mutually convenient timing. On the day of lecture(s) or interactions, the faculty member may be considered to be on duty at the beneficiary institution. Heads of the Institution may mutually alter the dates if such duties of assigned faculty members are seen to hamper important academic or evaluation assignments at his / her place of posting.
2. **Access to laboratories:** Students will have access to laboratories. However, beneficiary Institution will pay for the basic minimum cost of recurring items if anything is consumed.
3. **Joint Submission of Collaborative Projects** – Faculty members of both K. C. Das Commerce College and Tinsukia Commerce College may submit joint project proposals for funding from different funding agencies.


4. **Joint organization of Seminars / Symposia / Workshop** – Seminars / Workshop / Symposia may be jointly organized by faculty members of both K. C. Das Commerce College and Dhemaji Commerce College **Joint field work:** Both the Colleges may mutually organise field works which are part of the curriculum. This way both the institutions may utilise the expertise of individual faculty members for the benefit of the students.
5. **Guidance in Career counseling** – K. C. Das Commerce College and Tinsukia Commerce College will share information on career counseling and opportunities for higher students in India and abroad.
6. This is a non-binding MoU and there shall be no financial obligation on the part of both K. C. Das Commerce College and Tinsukia Commerce College

Both K. C. Das Commerce College and Tinsukia Commerce College agree that any information which is exchanged pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding will be kept strictly confidential and used solely for the purpose, covered by this Memorandum of Understanding, unless such information was obtained by a third party who does not have an obligation of confidentiality toward the information-disclosing party and entered public domain.

Subject to clause blow, both the Institutions may amend this Memorandum of Understanding by mutual consent in writing. Any amendment agreed by the Institutions shall come into effect from the date determined by the signing University on potential areas.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the date of signing and shall initially be valid for a period of three years. Thereafter both K. C. Das Commerce College and Tinsukia Commerce College shall agree on mutual consent on the continued validity of this Memorandum of Understanding.

In any other circumstance, or other detailed collaboration between the two parties, a separate MoA shall be drawn up as and when required.


